1. JT Case

1.1 Commissioners were updated on the current position in relation to the JT case namely a decision to destroy

DNA in this case and to bring forward a policy on arrangements for retention of DNA without conceding on any further substantial points contained in the initial Order 53 application for judicial review. Commissioners were advised that a decision on instructions to the barrister needed to be made at this meeting as Counsel required urgent instruction before the review hearing tomorrow.

- 1.2 Commissioners discussed in detail the update to the case and what options were available going forward.
- 1.3 Commissioners agreed to settle the case.

 Commissioners decided that settles terms should indicate to the PSNI that Article 8 and the Human Rights Act should be fully considered when formulating the new policy, and that a timeline be agreed for producing and publishing the policy and that the new policy will be made fully available to those affected by the policy.
