We are an organisation who protect and promote human rights in Northern Ireland.

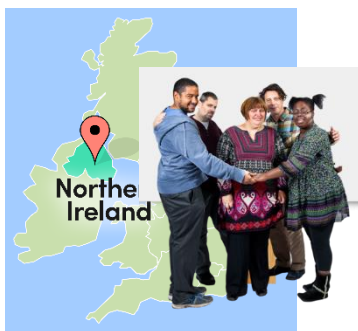
Human rights are the freedoms and protections that everyone should have.

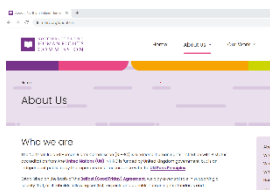
